FAQ

Q: What does the "Major+Other Major Courses" meaning?

A: It refers to "Major courses from your own department+Major courses from other departments". In other words, it means "**Major courses offered by KAC(IB/IR)+Major courses offered in English by other colleges**". However, you must complete at least 54 credits of Major courses from your own department.

Q: What does the "Balanced Liberal Arts+General Liberal Arts" meaning?

A: It refers to "Balanced Liberal Arts offered by KAC+General Liberal Arts offered outside of KAC that are conducted in English."

Q: What happens **if a student who enrolled before 2024 takes a course designated as a "Mandatory Major Courses"**?

A: It can be recognized as "Major Courses."

Q: I would like to know about **taking courses offered by outside of KAC!**

A: **Up to 21 credits** can be earned from English-taught courses offered outside of KAC during your enrollment. There are no limits on **2nd language(or Korean) courses**, but mother-tongue language cannot be approved. Besides, **Social Service, Career Selection/Self-Development/Entrepreneurship Courses (up to 2 courses)**, and **credits earned from partner universities abroad** can also be included.

Q: What should **students who entered before 2024 do if they haven't taken the "PROBABILITY & STATISTICS" course**, which was previously a required major foundation course?

A: As it changed to "Mandatory Major Course", it can be approved as "Major Course" if you take later.

3. Community Service

FAQ

Q: [Can foreign language scores, community service, or internships completed before admission be recognized as part of the graduation requirements?](#)

A: Only scores and activities that achieved after admission can be recognized.

Q: [When is the deadline for submitting the relevant supporting documents?](#)

A: In the case of English, 2nd language, and volunteer work, you have to submit the required documents **within the COMpass K submission period** after inputting to the EDWARD System. (If it is hard to visit the administration office, you can use the on-line submission period.) Even if you haven't registered for COMpass K, if you are in urgent need of graduation, please check the deadline with the administration office. You can submit the relevant internship documents anytime, and you have to submit both approval and completion reports to fulfill the requirement. If you need to graduate right after submission, please check the date with the administration office in advance.

FAQ

Q: Is it possible to **switch to "KAC Semester Bisa-Excellence"** even if i'm currently receiving "KAC Semester Truth"?

A: **It is possible if you submit the application and related certificates** during the application period.

Q: **Do I have to submit the application every semester** while I'm receiving the benefits?

A: You only need to submit it **once when applying**. However, **don't forget to register your English score** to the EDWARD system to maintain your qualification.

Foreign Language Scholarship

- ☐ KAC Students will receive a pre-determined amount of scholarships if they acquire the following minimum scores on a foreign language exam during their regular semester. (TOEFL(IBT) 80, IELTS 5.5, CEFR B1, TEPS 600 or NEW TEPS 327)
- ☐ The students who are in 3rd~7th semester can apply for it.
- ☐ It's a scholarship provided by the international cooperation team.
